- i. Change in focus:
  - 1. Regions are expert at delivering the member experience versus the national office.
  - 2. National organization to function as a resource center to the regions.
  - 3. Focus on Partnerships/sponsorships, fundraising, educational alignment and supporting systems.
- ii. 60 applicants
  - 1. Goal to select by the first of the year.
- h. Alignment Progress:
  - i. Level 1 Assessment
    - 1. 45 minutes per candidate
    - 2. Max 6 candidates per group
    - 3. 2 day event
    - 4. Non-bankable need to pass all pieces
    - 5. Option for 1 free retake with sign-off from Director that training to be successful is complete.
    - 6. Adaptive moving to 1 day assessments
    - 7. No weekend, in-house, Level 1s this year midweek dates available.
      - a. This is the best way to equitably support all members.
      - b. 90 level 1s on the calendar with 30 on weekends throughout the region.
  - ii. Level II & III
    - 1. Paired assessors for Alpine & snowboard, working on adaptive and telemark.
    - 2. Testing three day level III for Alpine last event of the year at Waterville Valley.
    - 3. Three day level III for Snowboarding, with paired assessors for both level III assessments this season.
